Keynote Speaker John D. Davis IV MD MHS

“Neurosurgeons in Politics and the Value of State Neurosurgical Societies.”

Davis recently completed terms on the Board of Directors of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons (AANS) and as Chairman of the Board of Directors of Neurosurgery PAC, organized neurosurgery's only political action committee in Washington, DC. He currently serves on neurosurgery's Washington Committee and as a member of the Nominating Committee of the AANS. He is former President of the Mississippi Neurosurgical Society, and he continues as a delegate from Mississippi to the Council of State Neurosurgical Societies where he previously served as Chairman of the Southeast Quadrant. Davis graduated from The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine in 1992. He earned a master's degree in Health Finance and Management, also at Johns Hopkins, and it was that training that spawned his interest in healthcare policy and economics as well as his vision for a spine center of excellence.
