SUBJECT: Preemption and Public Health

1	Whereas, 31 states (including Maryland) have passed tobacco control preemption laws; and
2 3	Whereas, 20 states (including Maryland) have passed preemption laws for paid sick leave; and
4 5	Whereas, 43 states (including Maryland) prohibit local laws tailored to reduce gun violence; and
6 7	Whereas, 12 states have passed preemption laws to undermine local control over nutrition
8 9	and food policy; and
10 11	Whereas, MedChi has often passed health policies on a local level to promote good public health policy; therefore be it
12 13 14	Resolved, that MedChi monitor and oppose efforts to change Maryland law regarding preemption in a way that is adverse to public health.
