SUBJECT: Withhold for Patients' Non-completion of Coordination of Insurance Benefits Form

Whereas, physicians provide care to patients who may have more than one insurance policy which covers 1 said treatment: and 2 3 Whereas, often patients do not provide information about all policies or coverage which pertains to their 4 health care: and 5 6 7 Whereas, physicians submit claims to insurance companies based on the information provided by the patient; and 8 9 Whereas, the insurance carriers have begun to withhold a portion of payment from the physician when the 10 patient has not completed a Coordination of Benefits form; and 11 12 Resolved, that MedChi develop regulation and/or legislation which would make it illegal to withhold 13 payment from physicians for patients' non completion of a Coordination of Benefits form when care has 14 already been rendered and a claim submitted to the patient's insurance carrier on record. 15 16 17 At its meeting on September 23, 2017, the House of Delegates referred Resolution 20-17 to the Board of 18 19 Trustees with report back at the next House of Delegates meeting.
