Whereas, in addition to his wife of 54 years, Maria, Dr. Magno is survived by a son, Raymar Magno of Elkridge, daughters, Dr. Romina Magno Thomas and Rebecca Chider of Towson, Florian Ward of Abingdon, Carlota Sumbilla of Windsor Will, Marcelina Miguel of Quezon City, Philippines, and six grandchildren; therefore be it
