

The MedChi Museum of Maryland Medical History



The *Center for a Healthy Maryland* has applied for a \$157,000 grant to coordinate a partnership between MedChi and Bithgroup Technologies to maintain and support a new web-based environmental health tracking system.

The Center for a Healthy Maryland submitted a proposal in response to the *Pfizer Independent Medical Education RFP* "Individualized Menopause Care".





The Maryland Health Care Coalition Against Domestic Violence completed their fiscal year, which began October 1st, 2022, by conducting 20 trainings through out Maryland. They reached 667 participants in total.

They conducted **2** open seminars on intersection of intimate partner violence (IPV) and HIV, as well as the health impacts of teen dating violence.

There are a total of 79 participants in the three programs. A new participant, referred by the Maryland Board of Acupuncture, is a first for MHPP.

MPHP has raised \$16,721 during their 45th Anniversary celebration.
