MEDCHI TO HOLD SPRING HOUSE OF DELEGATES MEETING APRIL 30

BALTIMORE, April 18, 2023 — MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society, will host their annual Spring House of Delegates meeting on Sunday, April 30, 2023.

This year, the April 30 House of Delegates meeting will include a presentation from Rahul Gupta, MD, the Director of National Drug Control Policy for the Biden Administration. Dr. Gupta wrote a thoughtful article on ending the X-waiver and expanding care for Opioid Use Disorders (OUD) in MedChi's recent issue of <u>Maryland</u> <u>Medicine</u> magazine. The meeting will kick off at 8:00 AM with a special address by Maryland's new Secretary of Health, Laura Herrera Scott, MD, MPH.

While Dr. Herrera Scott is only a few months in at her new position as acting secretary of health, already she is tackling some of the state's biggest challenges, including health inequalities and access to behavioral therapies."

Attending this meeting is a great way to get involved with healthcare issues and with MedChi for the betterment of healthcare for patients and physicians alike."
