# APPLICATION PERIOD FOR 2024 FOR MARYLAND PRIMARY CARE PROGRAM IS NOW OPEN

BALTIMORE, May 22, 2023 - Effective May 15th, the <u>application period</u> for practices, FQHCs, and CTOs to apply to participate beginning January 1, 2024 is now open and will run through Monday, July 17th at 11:59 PM. New practices and CTOs may apply to join the MDPCP during designated application periods. This includes those practices which were deferred in the previous Performance Year, as well as newly interested eligible practices and CTOs.

# **Current Application Period**

The Request for Applications (RFA) for PY2024 of the Maryland Primary Care Program is now available. Primary care practices, Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), and CTOs that are interested in joining the MDPCP as new participants should plan to apply during the open enrollment (effective May 15 and ending on Monday, July 17, 2023) for participation beginning January 1, 2024.
