**DEAN PAUL ROTHMAN, MD, TO SPEAK AT TENTH ANNUAL HUNT LECTURESHIP**

BALTIMORE, May 24, 2019 — MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society, and the Center for a Healthy Maryland will present the Tenth Annual Hunt Lectureship on Thursday, June 6, 2019. Dean Paul Rothman, MD, Chief of the Medical Faculty at Johns Hopkins Medical System, will be speaking at the event. As Dean and CEO, Dr. Rothman oversees both the School of Medicine and the Johns Hopkins Health, which encompasses six hospitals, a self-funded health plan, and hundreds of community physicians.

The Thomas Hunt Lectureship was established in 2008 to honor Dr. Thomas Hunt. Dr. Hunt is a retired orthopedic surgeon who practiced in Baltimore. The Hunt Lecture, as it is known, is comprised of physicians from Hopkins and the University of Maryland as well as members of the community who are interested in history and medicine and is presented by the History of Maryland Medicine Committee at MedChi to honor Maryland physicians who have made a significant contribution to medicine.

In this centennial anniversary of Sir William Osler's death, Dean Rothman's lecture will discuss how Osler's influence has spanned the century, with original ideas from the late 1800's coming full circle and being used in the practice of medicine today.

The lecture features a reception prior to the lecture and a question and answer session following it. The reception begins at 6:00 p.m. and the lecture begins at 6:30 p.m. in MedChi's historic Osler Hall. There is ample free and paid parking available in the immediate area.
