SUBJECT:	Enhanced CRISP Functionality to Provide a Physician to Physician Patient Communication Solution
Whereas, CRISP is a regional health information exchange (HIE) serving Maryland and the District of Columbia; and	
Whereas, CRISP's function is to "enable and support the healthcare community of Maryland and our region to appropriately and securely share data in order to facilitate care, reduce costs, and improve health outcomes;" and	
Whereas, since CRISP's inception it has enhanced the ability of physicians to access information about their patients in a safe and secure manner which has improved the continuity of care for patients; and	
Whereas, CRISP "offers a suite of tools aimed at improving the facilitation of care for our region's providers;" and	
Whereas, communication between physicians in a safe and secure manner is challenging at best given the various EMR programs and secure messaging platforms; and	
Whereas, physician to physician HIPAA compliant communication between physicians can be housed in CRISP instead of outside the exchange in various EMR or messaging systems; therefore be it	
Resolved, that MedChi encourage CRISP to add to its suite of tools a HIPAA-compliant physician to physician patient communication solution and urge CRISP to make this one of its highest priorities for innovation.
