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






The MDPCP: The What and Why

A central part of the Maryland Model is the Maryland Primary Care Program (MDPCP), intended to support the delivery of advanced primary care throughout the state and to allow community providers to play a vital role in prevention, improving health outcomes, and controlling total health care spending growth.

The MDPCP Partners: Where are you located?

To add yourself to the map: scroll to your location on the map, zoom in to your location, and drop the purple pin from the toolbar at your location.

- **To scroll:** click and hold the mouse button to scroll the map left, right, up, or down
- *To zoom:*
 - use the mouse wheel or trackpad to move in;
 - double click; or
 - use the on screen zoom control (top right hand corner)
- **Drag and drop** the purple pin from the toolbar on the left to mark your location (the bottom of the pin should point to your location).




MDPCP Portal: Overview

- An essential component of MDPCP program operations
- Designate a lead who has primary responsibility
- In the portal:
 - -Keep contact information up to date
 - -Update Practitioner and Staff Rosters
 - -Access payment and attribution data
 - -Complete reporting on the care transformation requirements
 - —Submit patient rosters for the Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CAHPS) survey
 - -Complete annual Financial Reporting



MDPCP Portal: Getting Access

- Register for a CMS Enterprise Portal ID, also referred to as an Enterprise Identity Management (EIDM) ID.
- Request IC Application Role.
- Request MDPCP Application Role.

MDPCP Portal: Where to Begin

Update your practice or CTO information:

• Demographic information (e.g., practice or CTO name, address, TIN), and point of contact information.

Practices and CTOs:

• Fill in your Staff Roster—Staff members at your practice or CTO other than the billing MDPCP Practitioners.


Practices:

• Update your Practitioner Roster—Include the primary care practitioners at your practice site who meet state licensure requirements, can bill Medicare, and who are participating in MDPCP.

Update or confirm your EHR information:

- Developer (EHR vendor)
- Product Name
- Product Version
- Certified Health IT Product List (CHPL) ID number or CMS EHR Certification ID

- Online, peer-to-peer learning platform
- Central hub for MDPCP communications, resources, and the MDPCP Learning Network.
- Access CMS and practice resources, such as MDPCP guidance documents, webinars, discussion groups, and the MDPCP Calendar.
- Interact through the site's Chatter feature, where practices and CTOs can ask questions, and share and discuss ideas, best practices, and helpful resources.
- Monitor important program deadlines and reminders
