BALTIMORE, February 27, 2025 — Since 1995, the month of March has been designated as "Women's History Month." The theme for Women's History Month for 2025 is "Moving Forward Together! Women Educating & Inspiring Generations." MedChi, along with The History of Medicine, is using this month to celebrate the collective strength and influence of women who have dedicated their lives to education, mentorship, and leadership.

The event will take place on Saturday, March 1, from 9:30 to 12:30 at the MedChi office in Baltimore. We are excited to have a panel of women in medicine and women at MedChi presenting.
