Whereas, medical supply companies are attempting to secure sales in an increasingly competitive market; 1 2 and 3 Whereas, they utilize direct to consumer advertising and pressured telephone solicitation to achieve sales, 4 particularly targeting the Medicare population; and 5 6 Whereas, sales pitches can contain misleading information regarding products, services and insurance 7 coverage thereof; and 8 9 Whereas, physician offices are being flooded with faxes and telephone requests from medical supply 10 companies to verify medical necessity and prescribe these products; and 11 12 Whereas, on review many of the product requests are not medically necessary or, frankly, fraudulent; 13 therefore be it; 14 15 Resolved, the MedChi will work to track patterns of unethical business practice by medical supply 16 companies and seek to bar offending companies from doing business in Maryland. 17 18
