SUBJECT: Medical Cannabis Compliance

Whereas, physicians are required to be certified providers by the Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission in order to recommend cannabis to a registered patient or caregiver; and

Whereas, certified providers may discuss the use of medical cannabis with a patient, including appropriate dosages and form; and

Whereas, MedChi has received reports of patients and licensed dispensaries failing to follow the recommendations given by the certifying provider; and

Whereas, at times, these recommendations are essential to the health and safety of the patient; and

Resolved, that it be the policy of MedChi that a licensed dispensary and a patient comply with a certifying provider's recommendation with regard to medical cannabis.
