## Resolution 12-19

INTRODUCED BY: Medical Cannabis Task Force

SUBJECT: Medical Cannabis Dosage and Warning Labels

Whereas, the Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission has implemented regulations that require licensed dispensary to comply with certain labeling and packaging requirements for the sale of medical cannabis; and

Whereas, it has been reported to MedChi that some THC oils only have dosage or warning labels on the outer packaging; and

Whereas, when a patient discards the outer packaging, the dosage and warning labels may not be evident on the inner packaging, which can lead to dosage and other errors; and

Whereas, The Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission strives to protect the public from negative health outcomes associated with the use of medical cannabis; and therefore be it

Resolved, that MedChi submit a request to the Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission to request that warning and dosage labels be on both the outer packaging and inner packaging for THC oils and other relevant products.
