Maryland Physician Health Program/Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program/Maryland Healthcare Professional Program – Laura Berg

The three programs continue to assist physicians and other healthcare professionals experiencing substance use, mental or emotional difficulties or other problems that may interfere with their personal or professional lives. As of April 25, there are a total of 110 participants in the three programs.

Grants Division – Shayna Banfield

The Certificate Program in Physician Leadership is continuing to offer the online leadership courses. To date, 34 people have completed the courses under this grant. The grant ends in September.

The Maternal Mortality Review Workgroup is finishing up work on 2017 maternal deaths. There were a record number of reviews this year. They will make recommendations to MDH during the summer.

The Maryland Health Care Coalition Against Domestic Violence continues to provide resources and make presentations around the state to hospitals and other groups. They are working on increasing their visibility through marketing and the internet.

Development & History – Meg Fielding

The History of Maryland Medicine Committee is planning the Hunt Lecture for June 6. Dean Paul Rothman, MD will be the speaker. The program is titled Sir William Osler, MD, Yesterday and Today. This year marks the 100th anniversary of his death.

We are also planning the Ethics Lecture for September 12. There will be a panel discussion on the Ethics of Genetic Editing. This lecture is supported by Dr. Tom Allen.

With Dr. Jensen's help, the Center has started working with the BSO to hold joint events. In November, 2018, we held an event – An Evening with the BSO and MedChi. The BSO presented an "Off the Cuff" Concert featuring Aaron Copeland's *Fanfare for the Common Man*. On April 6, we held our second event – Dinner and a Show. The BSO and Troupe Vertigo presented *Cirque Goes Hollywood*. This event was sold out.
