William P. Jones, M.D.

Whereas, On August 10, 2021, MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society and its component, The Anne Arundel County Medical Society, lost a distinguished and inspiring member of over forty years, William P. Jones, M.D.; and

Whereas, William P. Jones, M.D. was born on November 8, 1941 in Washington, DC; and

Whereas, after graduating from Archbishop Carroll High School in 1959, he earned a B.S. in Biology from Wheeling University in 1964, and then earned his M.D. from Georgetown University School of Medicine in 1698; and

Whereas; after graduating from Medical School, Dr. Jones served one tour in Vietnam as a Navy Lieutenant Medical Officer aboard the USS Niagara Falls where he earned the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry; and

Whereas; after completing his residency at George Washington University, Dr. Jones worked as an Emergency Physician at Suburban Hospital and then later opened a family practice while also working as a Deputy Medical Examiner for the State of Maryland; and

Whereas, Dr. Jones and his wife of 54 years, Patricia, were blessed with three children and six grandchildren: and

Whereas, Dr. Jones was a member of the Maryland Academy of Family Physicians, The Georgetown Clinical Society, and a Forty Year Member of MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society; and be it

Resolved, That the members of The Anne Arundel County Medical Society, MedChi and the MedChi House of Delegates have adopted this Resolution as an indication of the deep respect the medical community holds for William P. Jones, M.D.; and be it further
