SUBJECT: Wayne C. Spiggle, MD

Whereas, on July 31, 2020, MedChi, the Maryland State Medical Society, and its component, the Allegany County Medical Society, lost a member of long standing, Wayne C. Spiggle, M.D.; and

Whereas, Dr. Spiggle was born September 1, 1934, he earned a medical degree from The Medical College of Virginia School of Medicine in 1961; and

Whereas he completed his residency in Internal Medicine at the West Virginia University School of Medicine; and

Whereas Dr. Spiggle was co-founder of Braddock Heights Medical Group, treating patients and their families for 37 years; and

Whereas he was an attending physician at both Sacred Heart and Memorial Hospitals, and the Allegany County Community College; and

Whereas Dr. Spiggle was President of MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society in 1999; and

Whereas he was the recipient of numerous awards in his lifetime, including the 2013 Most Loyal West Virginia Physician Award, by the West Virginia University Alumni School of Medicine; and

Whereas Dr Spiggle was devoted to family, medicine, agriculture, and environmental conservation, owning a beef cattle farm, and serving as Chairman of the Board of Visitors for the University of Maryland's Appalachian Environmental Laboratory at Frostburg; and

Whereas he was elected and served as Mineral County Commissioner for six years; and

Whereas Dr. Spiggle helped develop Allegany Health Right to insure treatment for low-income citizens; and

Whereas, he is survived by his beloved wife, Betty Spiggle, children, Sheryl Lee, Lora Boe, Jennifer Suttie, Lee Brown, Dianne Scott, as well as 11 grandchildren, and 7 great - grandchildren: be it therefore

Resolved, that the members of the Allegany County Medical Society and the House of Delegates have adopted this resolution as an indication of the respect which the medical community held for Dr. Wayne Spiggle; and be it further
