- Bi-partisan political action committee of the AMA
- Oldest non-union political action committee formed in 1961
- Works with state medical society PACs as their federal campaign partner
- ∅ **Campaign School** – 1500 MDs since 1985; 100 past Cycle



AMPAC FUNDRAISING OVERVIEW

- **AMPAC YTD Cycle Raised = \$754,225.47**
- **2023 AMPAC Capitol Club Participation YTD:**
 - Platinum: 88 members (85 in YE 2022)
 - Gold: 211 members (234 in YE 2022)
