5 6 7 8 9	MedChi ran a nominal deficit in 2018. In 2019, MedChi ran a surplus significantly producing better than budget. While 2020 is not finished, and we have lots of uncertainty due to COVID-19, we feel this is a reasonable and fair budget.
