SUBJECT: Decreasing Medicare Payment Recovery Period

REFERRED TO: Reference Committee A

Whereas physicians must submit claims within six months in order to be considered for payment;
and

Whereas, Medicare often requests repayment of two-year-old claims causing a great deal of
difficulty for physicians and their staffs; therefore be it

Resolved, that the MedChi delegation submit a resolution to the AMA House of Delegates that
decreases the payment recovery period of Medicare and all insurers to six months after
submission.
