SUBJECT: Electronic Payment and Record Access

Whereas, MedChi and its members strive to be leaders and to help the health care industry to improve quality while reducing costs without reducing patient benefits or access to care; and

Whereas, MedChi supports the concept of a statewide and nationwide voluntary system of immediate, electronic health claims filing, adjudication, and payment; and

Whereas, all physicians should have appropriate access to standardized, secure patient health records; therefore be it

Resolved, that MedChi will encourage state and national government to evaluate voluntary use of a system of immediate payment and health record sharing; and be it further

Resolved, that MedChi will encourage the American Medical Association to evaluate the adoption of a national voluntary system of immediate electronic medical claims filing, adjudication, and payment.
