SUBJECT: Organizational Membership Category

1 Whereas, increasingly, physicians completing training are choosing employment instead of private 2 practice, and many private practice physicians are choosing employment too as an option; and

- 3 Whereas, employed physicians have a limited budget of professional association membership
- 4 benefits provided in their contracts which they reserve for their specialty societies and CME; and
- 5 Whereas, physician employers, including health systems, hospitals, and large group practices,
- 6 have an interest in being at the table with MedChi and its components; and
- 7 Whereas, allowing organizational membership is an opportunity to gain support of MedChi's and 8 its components' mission, and to build consensus and collaboration with physician employers, and
- 9 Whereas, all physicians, employed or not, may continue to join MedChi and its components as
- 10 active members; however, organizational members would not qualify as active members of
- 11 MedChi and its components presently; therefore be it
- Resolved, that MedChi and its components initiate development of an organizational membership which will be open to employers of physicians, not individual physicians; and be it further
- Resolved, that MedChi's Membership & Communications Council determine the category name,
 proposed rights, privileges, and dues structure associated with the new organizational membership
