Hilary T.S. O'Herlihy, M.D.

Whereas, On October 5, 2020, MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society, and its component, The Anne Arundel County Medical Society, lost a distinguished and inspiring member of over forty years, Hilary T.S. O'Herlihy, M.D.; and

Whereas, Hilary T.S. O'Herlihy, M.D. was born on June 13, 1930 in Cork, Ireland; and

Whereas, after graduating from University College in Cork in 1954, he traveled by steamship to the United States of America for an internship at St. Mary's Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania followed by residencies at Union Memorial Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland and the University of Saskatchewan in Saskatoon, Canada; and

Whereas; Dr. O'Herlihy completed a fellowship at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland before becoming Chief of Cardiology at Bon Secours Hospital; and

Whereas; he was instrumental in establishing the North Arundel Hospital, now known as University of Maryland Baltimore/Washington Hospital, where he admitted the very first patient and

Whereas, Dr. O'Herlihy and his wife of more than sixty years, Martha, helped to establish Hospice of the Chesapeake; and

Whereas, Dr. O'Herlihy and Martha, were blessed with six children, eighteen grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren; and

Whereas, Dr. O'Herlihy served as President of the Anne Arundel County Medical Society and as President of MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society; therefore be it

Resolved, That the members of The Anne Arundel County Medical Society, MedChi, and the MedChi House of Delegates have adopted this Resolution as an indication of the deep respect the medical community holds for Hilary T.S. O'Herlihy, M.D.; and be it further
