



MEMORIAL RESOLUTION

Jerome J. Coller, MD

Whereas, in June 2020, MedChi, the Maryland State Medical Society and its component, the Baltimore City Medical Society, lost a member of long standing, Jerome J Coller, M.D.; and

Whereas, Dr. Coller received his undergraduate education at Johns Hopkins University, his medical education at University of Maryland School of Medicine graduating in 1950; and

Whereas, he began a private practice in internal medicine in Baltimore that eventually expanded to include 15 physicians; and

Whereas, he joined the staff of then, Maryland General Hospital as physician adviser to quality assurance and utilization review, became medical director of Maryland Physicians Care in Linthicum Heights; and

Whereas, He was affiliated with Sinai Hospital and then Baltimore County Hospital, where he became the president of medical staff and chair of the Department of Medicine; and

Whereas, In 1978, He served as the first chair of the MedChi Physician Rehabilitation Committee (now, Physician Health Committee), pioneering the physician health movement in the state of Maryland he dedicated his efforts to helping his colleagues in need and became known to his colleagues as a “physicians’ physician”;

Whereas, Dr. Coller is survived by his wife, two sons, and four grandchildren; therefore, be it

Resolved, That the members of the Baltimore City Medical Society and the MedChi House of Delegates have adopted this Resolution as an indication of the respect which the medical community held for Dr. Coller; and be it further

Resolved, That this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and given to his wife and their children as an expression of the high esteem in which Dr. Coller is held by his colleagues.
