What is EQIP?

The Episode Quality Improvement Program (EQIP) is an episode based, advanced payment program for physicians. EQIP aims to provide incentive payments to improve quality of care and reduce cost. EQIP broadens access to Medicare's 5% Advanced APM MACRA opportunity, includes more providers in value-based payment, and helps meet the financial targets of the Total Cost of Care Model (TCOC). EQIP is the first value-based payment program designed for specialty physicians under Maryland's Total Cost of Care Model, and allows physicians to lead their own payment program while improving statewide cost and quality of healthcare.
