MEDCHI APPLAUDS HOGAN EXPANDING VACCINES TO AMBULATORY PHYSICIAN OFFICES

BALTIMORE, March 18, 2021 — Today, Governor Larry Hogan announced that ambulatory physician offices will be added to the team of groups giving the coronavirus vaccine. The Governor stated they have selected 19 medical offices throughout the state of Maryland that will be able to begin offering vaccinations to their patients in the coming weeks, once the state receives the upcoming boost in vaccine allotment as announced by the White House. MedChi, The Maryland State Medical Society, applauds the Governor's announcement and is hopeful it will allow Marylanders who have not yet been able to get vaccinated to have better and quicker access to a vaccine.
